Timber is increasingly being considered as a key material in delivering sustainable, energy efficient, offsite-manufactured buildings. Using timber from well-managed forests that meet internationally recognised standards of legality and sustainability, certified by organisations such as **PEFC**, **FSC** and **Grown in Britain**, is therefore a pre-requisite for all green building standards, as well as government and corporate responsible sourcing policies.

To ensure these requirements are met it is important that an inclusive responsible timber sourcing policy is set for your supply chain to ensure access to the full market of legal and sustainable timber products is maintained.
